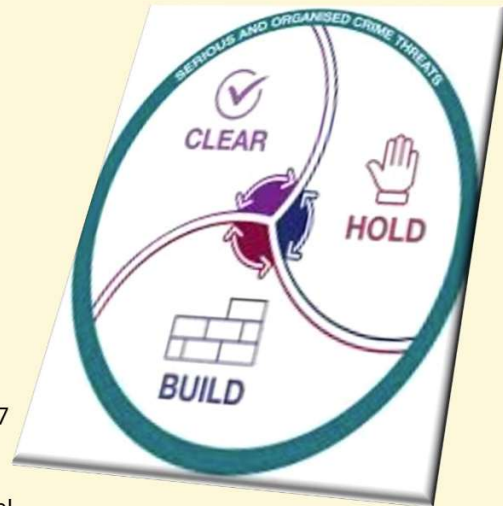
## Top 3 issues experienced by residents in the area through early LIP surveys, through Northamptonshire Talking, have highlighted- **Drug Dealing and Misuse, Burglary and Road Safety**

We are at the start of the clear phase, going through LIP analysis, identifying offenders, putting plans of action in place.

We have been in touch with the local school to design a logo for the area, the CHB team will pick the winning logo that will be used on our digital and physical media publications.

Plain clothes patrols are ongoing to scope out hot spots, problem areas etc.

We are also in talks with the local authority about their plans for when we hit the build phase – This is still some time away, however, we are keen to progress due to lead times and processes.

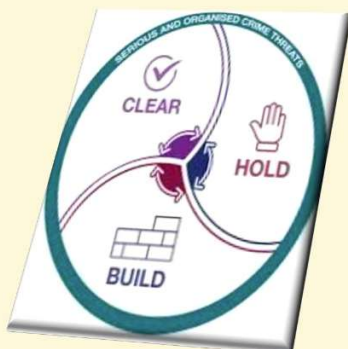


As part of the government uplift we are getting additional 27 officers across the county, 4 for WN & EN).
