Cafe

The cafe is still well supported with the food drink and raffle being popular with the regulars. For the first time a decision was taken to cancel a couple of afternoons because of the extreme heat.

The Flat

The renovations are now complete and a new contract drawn up by the letting agents. The rent has been increased to £700 with effect from October. It has been made quite clear that the tenants must contact the letting agents direct if they have any problems and the property will be inspected on a regular basis and a report forwarded to the committee.

Bookings
